

Inclement Weather Policy

Sunrise Girls Softball's (SGS) policy is to attempt to play all games and hold all practices when feasible. From time to time inclement weather may create unsafe playing conditions for scheduled practices and games. The determination that such unsafe conditions exist will be made by the President, Vice President or League Representative (Official); designated by the President or Vice President. The Official, will determine field play-ability as soon as reasonably possible prior to the beginning of scheduled practices and games. Notification of cancellation of practices or games will be made as soon as reasonably possible. The Official or On-field officials may also cancel a game at the field of play, if necessary. *Coaches* are not to call off games without authorization from the Sunrise Girls Softball Board of Directors per the above guidance.

To the extent it is possible, all scheduled games will be played per the posted schedules. Due to field availability and time constraints, SGS cannot guarantee that all games impacted by inclement weather will be rescheduled, every effort will be made to make up the games canceled.

In case of inclement weather, the Sunrise Girls Softball home webpage and Facebook page will be updated to indicate field conditions and the status of games; as well as to provide other weather related information. A determination will be made and the website updated by 3:30pm for weekday games, weekend games will have a determination made at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time; if cancellation of games is apparently necessary due to inclement weather. SGS strongly encourages each parent to check the website or Facebook up to 30 minutes prior to coming to the fields for games, as conditions may change. If the website doesn't indicate any adverse weather conditions, postponements, or cancellations, one may assume that all games (or practices) for that day will be played as scheduled. SGS does not cancel away games but will work in coordination with those leagues to determine whether or not games will be played.
